LOOK

Window: Each family of notes has its own see through feature. When held up to the light, the clear area of the feature fills in with colour.

FEEL

The Banknote should feel stiff and crisp, not limp, waxy or shiny.

TILT

SPARK®: There is an area of shiny metallic ink which changes colour as you move the note around.

CHECK

Always compare both sides of a suspect note to one that you know to be genuine. Any difference will become apparent more easily. Checking under ultraviolet (UV) light will show areas on the note that are different colours that glow.







