Scottish Business Statistics

Business Start-up Statistics are produced quarterly by The Committee of Scottish Bankers (CSCB). Contributing banks are Bank of Scotland, Clydesdale Bank, Lloyds TSB Scotland and The Royal Bank of Scotland.

Users of the Start-up data published here should bear in mind the following notes, which describe various developments that have taken place in relation to production of the figures:

- With effect from quarter one 2002, the geographical locations of new businesses have been charted using postcode sectors. Prior to then, the location of the branch where the account was opened was used.
- With effect from quarter one 2009, presentation of the data has been further enhanced to reflect the replacement of the Local Enterprise Company structure with six Enterprise Regions.
- With effect from quarter one 2009, data has been reported by UK Parliamentary constituency.
- With effect from quarter one 2013, data has been collated using updated Scottish and UK Parliamentary constituency boundary information. New, additional, data tables reflecting the boundary changes are now displayed.
- With effect from quarter one 2013, a 3-fold Urban/Rural split has been included.

Due to the changes in methodology for compiling data, direct comparison between data since the changes occurred and that for previous years is not recommended.
