Tactile Emboss
There are two arrangements of four dots in a square formation, enabling physical identification for the visually impaired.

Raised Print
The banknotes have the characteristic raised print which you can feel with your finger tips across each bank note. This also assists with identification for the visually impaired.

LOOK

Window: Each family of notes has its own see through feature and clear window design that you can look through.

FEEL

The Banknote should feel stiff and crisp, not limp, waxy or shiny.

TILT

SPARK®: There is an area of shiny metallic ink which changes colour as you move the note around.

CHECK

Always compare both sides of a suspect note to one that you know to be genuine. Any difference will become apparent more easily.

Checking under ultra-violet (UV) light will show areas on the note that are different colours that glow.
